CODE OF

CONDUCT: The 100% Pure NZ 2011 Winter Games requires all athletes and coaches to follow the Winter Games Code Of Conduct. A copy of this can be viewed on the Winter Games website, at <http://wintergamesnz.com/accounts/register/>

ELIGIBILITY: Refer to FIS/ IPC Continental Cup Rules 2010/2011.

ENTRY: Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS/ IPC quotas and rules. All entries must go through the Winter Games NZ online registration system. The main purpose of the online system is to replace the manual process of submitting paper-based entry forms by fax or email. The information required to enter is the same as on the IPC forms you would usually submit. A copy can be printed for one's own records. The link for FIS / IPC event registration is only accessible to the National Sport Associations for submitting team entries.



The Registration process works as follows:

1. Click on the link provided to National Sports Associations via email. If your National Association hasn't received it please contact jesst@wintergamesnz.com.
2. Create a user account for the online system.
3. Once activated you can create teams and add athletes and officials. After you submit a team, you can log back in and edit your team. You can add or remove athletes, edit athletes and officials at any time until registration closes. It will automatically update on our system.
4. To get confirmation of your entry sent to your email, click the button "Send Team list as PDF".
5. Encourage your team athletes to submit their athlete biographies at www.wintergamesnz.com/accounts/register/

DEADLINE: Online entries close on Tuesday 9th August 2011 at 0000 (midnight). Entries will still be accepted after this time at the Winter Games office in the Lake Wanaka Centre, up to Wednesday 10th August 2011 at 1500.

TRAIL PASSES: Trail passes for registered athletes and coaches are provided by Winter Games NZ for the day of the event in which the athlete is participating in, ie. 13th, 14th and/or 16th August 2011.
